



APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL AID

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

- *DACAmented scholars can submit a free FAFSA application even though they are technically ineligible for Federal Financial Aid*
- *By completing the FAFSA form, DACA students would receive a Student Aid Report (SAR) which can be used to apply for institutional aid and other scholarships*
- *Undocumented students should NOT submit an online FAFSA form, but they can fill out a print copy of the FAFSA form and hand it to individual institutions, who do the in-house calculations*



TIPS FOR STUDENTS WITH UNDOCUMENTED PARENTS

1. *Enter all zeroes for parents' social security numbers-- do NOT make up a number or use a taxpayer ID number!*
2. *It is normal to feel nervous about submitting the FAFSA, but feel reassured that FAFSA never directly shares your information with immigration authorities. The probability of your information reaching immigration authorities is very unlikely.*
3. *Parents should physically sign the printed out form rather than using the four-digit PIN number electronic signature.*
