

IF ICE COMES TO YOUR HOME OR SCHOOL:

1. Make a plan with your loved ones
2. Know your rights
3. Have outside counsel to evaluate the warrant

Do not open doors.

ICE cannot enter your home unless if they have a warrant signed by a judge.

Remain calm and silent.

Do not answer any questions-- anything you say or do can be held against you. Remain calm and silent. Ask for an interpreter if you don't understand the language/

Report & Record.

If you see someone being detained by ICE, write down relevant information and take photos. You can then call the Immigrant Defense Project's hotline (212.725.6422) to report the raid and find out if the person is eligible for an attorney.

Do not sign anything.
